VIDEO SCRIPT**

1	Open with a montage of stylized shots. We see scenes of TU Police and Security personnel as part of campus life. Patrolling on bikes, in cars, on foot; interacting with students, parents, and university staff.	(MUSIC up.) NARRATOR (V/O): Temple University Campus Safety Services.... We're here 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to assist Temple students, employees and visitors.
2	As a part of this montage a graphic builds: TEMPLE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS SAFETY SERVICES PREVENTION – PARTNERSHIP – PRIDE	NARRATOR (V/O): We're a key resource for the university. Our role is reflected in our motto: Prevention, Partnership and Pride. (MUSIC transition.)
3	Visual transition from stylized to documentary look. We see Carl Bittenbender speaking on-camera.	CARL BITTENBENDER (O/C): For our team in Safety Services, security and safety are central concerns. But I always like to say, we're more than a police department.
4	Show officers in various environments as they interact with students: directing traffic, giving directions, helping with a broken down auto.	BITTENBENDER (V/O now): We're always seeking new ways to improve the quality of life here at Temple and to build a strong campus community.
5	Now we see 3 students, one at a time, making comments on-camera.	STUDENT 1 (O/C): Since I came here three years ago, I've always felt at home. STUDENT 2 (O/C): I feel a lot better knowing we have police officers right here on campus. Twenty-four hours a day, they're right here if we need them. STUDENT 3 (O/C): If you have a problem or a question, the police here are easy to approach. STUDENT 4 (O/C): I have no hesitation telling students and their parents that Temple is a safe place to learn.

6	Various shots of group of officers at Center Station.	<p>(MUSIC transition.)</p> <p>(MUSIC up then under.)</p> <p>NARRATOR (V/O): The Temple Campus Police Division is staffed by professional law enforcement officers.</p>
7	Dissolve to demo of CPR and AED training.	NARRATOR (V/O): Each officer is certified in C.P.R., first aid and in the use of Automated External Defibrillators.
8	Show security watching residents scan in at dorm.	We also have a Security Division. These officers monitor campus facilities and are stationed at residence halls 24 hours a day.
9	Transition to scenes illustrating points about Dispatching Center.	In our communications center, we use the latest computer-based technology to effectively deploy our police and security personnel.
10	Show CAD computer screen. Decide on shot that illustrates emergency response.	This state-of-the-art center is integrated with the Philadelphia Police 9-1-1 system for coordination with local law enforcement.
11	Show campus night scenes... Broad Street, SAC, Library.	NARRATOR (V/O): To keep the busy campus safe at all hours, an extensive lighting system has been installed. It's another reason we say, "The sun never sets at Temple."
12	Visual transition to Moncia Hankins of Campus Safety Services on-camera.	<p>(MUSIC transition.)</p> <p>MONCIA HANKINS (O/C): We also provide campus escorts. Dusk to dawn, seven days a week</p>
13	Scenes: student phones for escort; escort on foot; escort via van (if possible, shoot van scene in evening).	HANKINS: (V/O now): Temple students, faculty and other employees can easily arrange an escort throughout the campus community.
14	We see Charles Leone on-camera.	<p>(MUSIC transition.)</p> <p>CHARLES LEONE (O/C): Our department is very proud of our high level of involvement on campus, beyond our duties as police and security officers.</p>

15	Scenes from Orientation.	LEONE (V/O now): We're always active in Student Orientation – from helping with move-in to acclimating students to campus life.
16	Show scenes from classes and/or Listening Circle.	LEONE (V/O): And our outreach includes other services. We offer self-defense classes, alcohol awareness programs, and regular Listening Circles where we get together with students to hear what's on their minds.
17	Now we see 3 students, one at a time, making comments on-camera.	STUDENT 4 (O/C): The police here really do get involved. STUDENT 5 (O/C): With the bike patrol, I always feel like there's an officer around. STUDENT 6 (O/C): They help keep us safe. And they do it in a friendly way. STUDENT 7 (O/C): I've been coming to Temple for three years now, and I've always felt safe.
18	We see Carl Bittenbender speaking on-camera.	(MUSIC transition.) BITTENBENDER (O/C): I have 32 years as a police officer, first on the Philadelphia force, and now here at Temple. I'm also a parent of a Temple student. I try to bring to my job what I've learned in both roles.
19	Return to scene of officers gathered for still photo, show happy friendly faces and camaraderie between them.	BITTENBENDER (V/O): We work very hard to be both highly professional, and genuinely caring.
20	Transition back to stylized look from opening. Title graphic is reprised: TEMPLE UNIVERSITY CAMPUS SAFETY SERVICES PREVENTION – PARTNERSHIP – PRIDE	(MUSIC transition.) NARRATOR (V/O): We're here – where you need us, when you need us. Day or night. To make your experience at Temple the very best it can be. (MUSIC up.)
